ROUND TOP, TEXAS, one of the smallest incorporated communities in Texas, is on the old La Bahía Road between La Grange and Brenham in Fayette County.

The earliest settlers were Englishmen who came to the area from other parts of the United States starting in 1826.

In the early 1840s German immigrants began moving into the Round Top area and by the 1850s they were the dominate population of Round Top.

In 1850 Round Top had a population of 150, two stores, blacksmith shop, two saloons, a post office, and a line of tri-weekly stagecoach serving the citizenry.

On this **1.8** miles walking tour you will see structures that represent the history of Round Top.
